## **Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 3314 moves the Home Bakery Act from Title 2 back to Title 63, where it was originally created in 2013, and repeals four sections that are replaced by the measure. The measure expands the definition of "prepared food" to include processed food that does not require refrigeration; meat products are not allowed. The measure defines a "home food establishment and caps the gross annual sales at \$20,000.
