Research Analysis

HB 3317 increases, from 20 to 150, the number of absentee ballot affidavits that a notary public can notarize in a single election. The bill also adds two categories of voters who may apply for an absentee ballot to include persons over the age of 60 and those who have been issued a physical disability placard.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3317, as introduced, increases the maximum number of ballots a notary may notarize. It also provides that registered voters over the age of 60 years or those issued a physical disability placard may request absentee ballots.

After analysis, the measure is not expected to have an impact on the state budget.
