**Research Analysis**

The proposed subcommittee substitute for HB 3323 requires each school district board of education, prior to the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, to coordinate with their local emergency medical service provider and develop a plan for providing emergency medical services at athletic events held at school district facilities.

The plan shall be reviewed and updated annually as appropriate and placed on file with the school district and the emergency medical services provider.
