Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3346 requires all public schools that issue identification cards and serve students in grades seventh through twelfth, to print the telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline on the ID card starting July 1, 2021.

The proposed committee substitute also states that it is the intent of the legislature, through this act, to allow public and private institutions of higher education to print the telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, and similar phone numbers, on their ID cards.
