Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides the ability for counties to sell, transfer, trade of otherwise dispose of equipment or material to other counties or political subdivisions without applying existing bid requirements. The ability to negotiate between governmental entities is likely to provide opportunities for cost control and improved efficiencies in the management of county equipment and materials. Any such benefits will depend on the structure of each transaction.
