**Research Analysis**

HB 3368 makes insurers who fail to compensate out-of-network practitioners liable for damages, provided that practitioner has met all the necessary requirements for benefit assignment. After notice and hearing, the Insurance Commissioner may impose an additional fine on the insurer. These fines will be collected in the State Insurance Commissioner Revolving Fund.
