Research Analysis

HB 3369, as introduced, reduces the percentage of state aid, from 5% to 3%, a sponsoring school district can retain from a charter school for administrative services rendered.

The measure further prohibits a sponsoring district from charging a charter school any additional fees, unless the fees are for services rendered.

HB 3369 requires the charter school sponsor to provide to the State Department of Education financial records documenting any state funds retained by the sponsor for administrative services rendered for the previous year.
