**Research Analysis**

The proposed Committee Substitute to HB 3373 creates the "Shelby Johnson and Logan Deardorf Act of 2020". The bill requires a physician or doctor to notify the Department of Public Safety with 1 week of diagnosis of any illness or injury that would impair the ability of an individual to operate a motor vehicle. A physician who intentionally violates the provisions may be charged with a misdemeanor.
