HB 3374 authorizes a board of county commissioners, at the request of the county sheriff, to enter into contracts for security guard services at county facilities. The sheriff would be responsible for selecting and administering security plans for the counties.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure permits county commissioners to contract with private security agencies or guards for services in buildings where sheriffs are required to provide security of prisoners. The provision is permissive and not mandatory. Any cost for such services will be incurred by the county.
