HB 3377 makes assault and battering upon a municipal or county code official a felony punishable by imprisonment for a term not to exceed 5 years, a fine of up to \$5,000 or both fine and imprisonment.

## Fiscal Analysis

HB 3377 creates a felony and the penalty of a term no more than 5 years in Dept. of Corrections (DOC) custody and/or an associated fine of not more than \$5,000. The impact to the state is anticipated to be minimal. Currently, it costs \$60.11/day or \$21,940/year for DOC to incarcerate one individual.
