Research Analysis

The FA to HB 3384 modifies multiple components of the bill.

The FA modifies the definition of *cigar bar* removing the requirements that a cigar bar be established as of 2020, be primarily located in an enclosed indoor space, and that 35% of its gross receipts be derived from tobacco products. The 35% gross receipts requirement is reduced to 25%. Further, the FA adds to the definition of cigar bar a tobacco retailer displaying more than 100 cigars within a licensed cigar bar.

The FA modifies the definition of *recreational area* to remove examples.

The FA modifies the definition of *retail tobacco store* to include devices that heat, rather than burn, tobacco. The FA also allows for food and beverages to be sold within retail tobacco stores.

The FA changes the definition of *vapor shop* to mean any retail establishment that derives more than 80% of its revenue from vapor products.

The FA allows for smoking in outdoor recreational areas.
