**Research Analysis**

The PCS 3386 removes the provision that any board member of a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) may be removed for violating the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The measure also requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to reimburse FQHCs, at a minimum, the cost-based prospective payment system rate for Medicaid-covered services.
