**Research Analysis**

HB 3389, as introduced, requires the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State Regents for Higher Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education, to study and make recommendations to the legislature regarding possible changes to state public school graduation requirements.

The measure requires the State Board of Education to engage stakeholders, including educators, business members and community partners.

The Board is required to submit any recommendations by the start of the 2021 Legislative Session, and may continue the study thereafter as needed.
