Research Analysis

HB 3407 allows craft distiller licensees to manufacture, bottle, package, and store spirits they have produced; sell spirits both in and out of state to qualified persons; serve free samples on the premises; sell spirits for either on- or off-premises consumption; sell spirits at public events; purchase wine and beer from wholesale licensees; sell wine and beer for on-premises consumption; and operate spirit lounges.

The measure also allows craft distiller spirit lounge licensees to manufacture, bottle, package, and store spirits on the premises; sell spirits for either on- or off-premises consumption; sell spirits at public events; hold a mixed beverage, beer and wine, or caterer license; and hold a craft distillery self-distribution license.

Finally, the measure sets forth annual license fees for craft distiller, craft distiller self-distribution, spirit lounge, and spirit lounge self-distribution licenses.

The measure will go to a vote of the people to authorize a constitutional amendment to allow the sale of spirits to consumers.
