Impact:	Tax Commission: Minimal Increase in Motor Vehicle Collections

Research Analysis

The proposed Committee Substitute to HB 3415 allows for the registration and issuance of a license plate for “street-legal utility vehicles” and allows these vehicles to be operated on all streets and highways except the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways. The operation of a street-legal utility vehicle on the streets and highways of this state requires the vehicle be issued a certificate of registration and license plate to be renewed annually.

Fiscal Analysis

Analysis provided by the Tax Commission:

Currently, utility vehicles used exclusively off the roads and highways which were purchased on or after July 1, 2008¹ are subject to an initial and nonrecurring registration fee of \$11 and are not subject to standard motor vehicle registration fees levied pursuant to Section 1132(A) of Title 47. The newly created classification of street-legal UTVs would be subject to the fees imposed in Section 1132(A) in the same manner as other motor vehicles. Consequently, a minimal increase in motor vehicle revenues is estimated for FY 21 and FY 22.

¹ Off road UTVs purchased prior to July 1, 2008 may be registered at the option of the owner subject to the \$11 nonrecurring registration fee.
