**Research Analysis**

The second proposed committee substitute for HB 3460 allows all educational institutions to designate specific student information as classified directory information. Directory information includes a student's name, address, and phone number.

Any educational institution that is not the primary custodian of the directory information, but can access the directory for educational purposes, is prohibited from releasing or selling the information without written consent of the local school board.

The State Board of Education and the State Department of Education are not permitted to designate student information as classified directory information, as stated above. The SDE and the SBE shall keep personally identifiable student information confidential unless authorized otherwise by federal law.
