**Research Analysis**

The PCS HB 3463 modifies the definition of “long-term care facility” to include the nursing facility component of a continuum of care facility. The measure also requires that when a resident of an assisted living center is prescribed an antipsychotic drug, the facility is required to ensure that the resident is reassessed by a medical provider at least quarterly and the results documented in the record. Additionally, all resident care staff must understand the benefits and side effects of the medication. The measure also outlines procedures to be followed if an antipsychotic drug is prescribed to a resident on an as-needed basis,
