**Research Analysis**

The PCS for HB 3496 allows hunting of furbearers pursuant to rules promulgated by the Wildlife Conservation Commission and directs the commission to set season dates and bag limits for squirrel. The measure repeals two sections related to trapping on inhabited lands and trapping devices.
