## **Research Analysis**

HB 3515 requires law enforcement officers to use audio or video recording equipment at all times when responding to a call for service or at the initiation of any other encounter between officers and members of the public. The measure prohibits officers from editing, redacting, erasing, copying, sharing, altering, or distributing any recordings unless authorized by federal or state law or policy of the law enforcement agency. Any officer who violates this measure with the intent to obstruct justice will be charged with a misdemeanor.
