**Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 3619 prohibits a municipality or county from adopting ordinances, rules or codes restricting connections to facilities of utility providers lawfully operating in this state. The measure also prohibits discrimination in adoption of rules or codes against one or more utility providers based upon the nature or source of the utility service provided.
