HB 3654 allows the county clerk's office to issue an ID card with information related to the discharge of returned soldiers and sailors. The ID card can be issued in lieu of or in addition to any receipt issued when the discharge is filed.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure provides that a county clerk's office may issue an identification card with indexed information related to discharge documents in lieu of, or in addition to, any receipt issued with such filings.
