**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3666 directs the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to establish rules to help prevent cross-pollination of industrial hemp crops and limit the number of applications for industrial hemp growth licenses in areas that are close together. The measure also directs the department to create a registry of licensees and harvest reports that is accessible online to the public.
