**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute (2) to HB 3683 provides that an elected or appointed state, county, township, city, town, or other officer not subject to impeachment may be fined a minimum of \$500 for a listed cause. The measure adds habitual absence from training events and dereliction of duty to the list of causes. The measure provides that it is the duty of the district attorney to institute proceedings in district court against an office holder upon receipt of notice in writing and verified by 51% of the registered voters that voted in the previous election for the political subdivision of which the officer is a member.
