HB 3717 directs the state to pay for the funeral of a member of the Oklahoma National Guard who has died on state active duty.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3717, as introduced, provides for the payment of up to \$2,000 in reasonable funeral expenses for members of the Oklahoma National Guard if they die while on state active duty.

After consultation with Brigadier General Mancino of the Oklahoma Military Department, this bill is estimated to have no material impact on the state budget. The analysis of the OMD concluded that a guard member dying on state active duty was a highly unlikely event. General Mancino was not aware of any instances of guard members dying while on state active duty over the past 30 years.
