**Research Analysis**

HB 3736, as introduced, mandates that each eligible student participating in a teacher internship program regulated by the Regents for Higher Education be awarded a one-time stipend of \$4,000.

Currently, only students who have completed the minimum teacher internship are eligible to participate in the paid teacher internship program.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Upon consultation with the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability, there were approximately 1,300 student teachers last year. Based on that count, it is anticipated that the measure would have an approximated fiscal impact of \$5,200,000. This is contingent upon the number of students who choose to participate in the program.
