**Research Analysis**

FA1 to HB 3767 provides that an officer of DPS or other political subdivision may cause to be removed a vehicle when the vehicle is left unattended upon any street, sidewalk, alley or thoroughfare, and constitutes a hazard or obstruction to the normal movement of vehicular, public transit or pedestrian traffic. An unattended vehicle is deemed to constitute an obstruction if any portion of the vehicle remains in that lane of traffic designated by traffic lane markings or if any portion of the vehicle is outside of the designated parking location and protrudes into the lane of traffic.
