HB 3781 creates the following road and bridge designations:

- A bridge on State Highway 9 in Kiowa County as the “WWII Doolittle Raider – Bombardier Sgt. Robert James ‘R.J.’ Stephens Memorial Bridge”
- A bridge on State Highway 34 in Beckham County as the “Keith N. Cantrell, PFC U.S. Army Memorial Bridge”
- A section of State Highway 82 in Cherokee County as the “Paul Blevins, Jr. and Michael Rogers Memorial Highway”
- A bridge on State Highway 43 in Coal County as the “Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran Memorial Bridge”
- A section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County as “South Mickey Mantle Boulevard”
- A section of State Highway 18 in Payne County as the “Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway”
- A bridge on State Highway 51 in Broken Arrow as the “Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge”
- A bridge on Interstate Highway 44 in Lawton as the “Major Charles E. Stiles Memorial Bridge”
- A section of State Highway 28A in Rogers County as the “CSM Junior H. Honeycutt Memorial Highway”
