**Research Analysis**

HB 3790 prohibits the revocation of a suspended sentence, in whole or part, for using or possessing medical marijuana pursuant to a valid medical marijuana patient license unless the sentencing court previously found that, based on material evidence, prohibiting the otherwise lawful use and possession of medical marijuana is necessary and appropriate to accomplish the goals of sentencing.
