Research Analysis

HB 3791 allows a pharmacist to substitute a prescribed drug for an interchangeable product, provided the substitute drug has been deemed by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration as interchangeable. The prescribing pharmacist must authorize the substitution and the pharmacist must inform the patient of the substitution. The substitution must be electronically recorded. Lastly, the measure directs the State Board of Pharmacy to maintain a list of all drugs with a FDA-approved interchangeable products.
