## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure relates to governmental entities that transact business online, requiring posting of information regarding the collection of personal information to be collected and the purposes for which such information is to be used. Notice must be given should additional categories of information be collected. Should a governmental entity sell consumer personal data the website must provide information on the categories of information about the consumer, the categories that would be sold, or not sold and any disclosure intentions.

While disclosures on websites are required under the provisions of the measure, no measureable fiscal costs are anticipated.
