Research Analysis

HB 3805, as introduced, creates the “Advanced Roles for Teachers and School Leaders Act”. The measure directs the State Board of Education (SBE) to establish a three year pilot program with the purpose of supporting advanced roles for teachers, recognizing teachers who demonstrate advanced roles through increased compensation, and allowing principals to expand their leadership capabilities, among other things.

By December 31, 2020, the SBE shall create standards for the pilot program, and by January 31, 2021, the SBE shall issue a request to Oklahoma schools for program proposals.

The measure outlines how appropriated funds should be spent on the program and directs the SBE to evaluate the program after three years of implementation.

Lastly, the measure exempts program participants from limitations on class size, provided the classes are under the leadership of a lead or master teacher and are part of a larger effort to implement new instructional models and improve school-wide performance.

Fiscal Analysis

While the measure is expected to have a fiscal impact, consultation with the State Department of Education regarding the measure is ongoing. However, with an unknown number of certified personnel who may qualify for the enhanced compensation and professional development opportunities, it is difficult to quantify the total fiscal impact on the state or school districts.
