**Research Analysis**

HB 3807, as introduced, requires the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability to issue a report to the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore, and the Governor, detailing factors that contribute to:

- Improvements in the common education system
- Improvements in higher education
- Improvements in the state's workforce

Should the Commission find there is insufficient information to fulfill any of the report's objectives, the report shall detail ways to address these information gaps.

The report shall be submitted by October 31, 2020.

**Fiscal Analysis**

It has not yet been determined how much data is available or the materials that would be needed in order to fulfill the objectives outlined in the measure. If the Office for Educational Quality and Accountability can utilize its existing staff to meet the goals of the measure, the cost would be minimal with the exception of printing costs of approximately \$2,000. If the agency needs to contract staff to assist in developing and preparing the report, the fiscal impact may be approximately \$25,000 based on similar projects in the past.
