Research Analysis

HB 3817, as introduced, requires the Office of Management and Enterprise Service to prominently display the national motto of the United States in all state buildings. The measure specifies that buildings owned by school districts are not included in this requirement.

The bill authorizes the Oklahoma Attorney General to prepare and present a legal defense of the display if its legality or constitutionality is questioned.

Fiscal Analysis

REVISED

HB 3817 requires the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to display the national motto in all state buildings. Officials from OMES estimate a cost of \$250 per building to display such motto. OMES estimates 342 properties operating as state office buildings would be impacted by the measure; therefor, the measure's total cost to OMES is estimated to be \$85,500.

Note: a previous version of this impact, understated the number of impacted properties by only considering buildings that OMES directly operates.
