Research Analysis

HB 3824 creates the “State Government Transparency in Billing Act.” The measure provides that the legislative and judicial branches of state government are exempt from all fees and costs for services provided by any appropriated state agency.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3824 in its current form exempts the Legislative and Judicial Branches of state government from fees and costs for services provided by appropriated state agencies. Legislative Branch entities expected to be impacted by the measure include the House of Representatives, the State Senate, and the Legislative Services Bureau. Judicial Branch entities expected to be impacted by the measure include the Supreme Court, the Court of Criminal Appeals, the Workers Compensation Court – Court of Existing Claims, the Workers Compensation Commission; and the District Courts.

Based on anticipated rate models, officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, (OMES), estimate an annual revenue loss to their Information Services Division (OMES-ISD) as a result of HB 3824, as well as, corresponding savings to the Legislative and Judicial Branches. OMES estimates are as follows

OMES Revenue Loss	(\$450,253)
Legislative Branch Savings	\$40,346
Judicial Branch Savings	\$409,907
