HB 3841 makes it a felony for a person who is receiving temporary total disability benefits to fail to report a material change in income to an employer, insurance carrier, or third-party administrator.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3841 creates a felony charge for failing to report a medical change. This could increase the amount of individuals incarcerated in Dept. of Corrections' custody. The impact is most likely minimal: however, the average daily cost to incarcerate one person is \$60.11 or \$21,940 annually. The overall cost to the state is dependent upon how many people are convicted and the length of their sentence that is imposed.
