Research Analysis

HB 3860, as introduced, creates the County Road Enhancement and Development Fund. Funds would be made available solely for purposes of construction, maintenance, and reconstruction of county roads and bridges. A county may request a distribution from the fund annually, subject to certain limitations.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3860 in its current form creates the County Road Enhancement and Development Fund, (CRED Fund), and provides that funds deposited to the CRED Fund be distributed to the various counties for construction, maintenance and reconstruction of county roads and bridges. The measure does not provide a funding source for the CRED Fund, so as currently drafted the measure anticipates the Fund would be funded through legislative appropriations. Whether the Legislature will choose to appropriate funds to the CRED Fund in the future is unknown. HB 3860 in its current form includes no such appropriation; therefor, the measure has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
