Research Analysis

HB 3880 specifies that the \$50.00 license fee for operating a residential care home will be a probationary license which will expire 36 months from the date of issuance. Renewal licenses will be \$25.00 per year and may be issued for up to 36 months. The measure also provides that:

- the license to operate an adult day care may be issued for a period of up to 36 months;
- the initial license to operate a continuum of care facility or assisted living center is \$10.00 for each bed, and the renewal fee will be \$10.00 for each bed, per year of licensure, and
- the license fee for a continuum of care facility that includes an adult day care component is \$75.00 per year of licensure, up to 36 months.
