Research Analysis

Floor Amendment 1 to HB 3884 moves the sunset date back from 2025 to 2021. The amendment modifies the training requirement to encompass officers elected or appointed after November 1, 2020. The language clarifies that officers would be required to complete orientation training within 90 days after the general election of their first term, Basic Certification by the end of the first term, Advanced I certification by the end of the second term, and Advanced II certification by the end of the third term. Alternative timelines are provided for officers already holding office on November 1, 2020.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure re-creates the Commission on County Government Personnel Education and Training through July 1, 2021 and modifies the training and continuing education requirements for elected county officials. A determination of any costs or savings resulting from the provisions remains ongoing, however the courses offered are developed by the Commission and the Cooperative Extension Service. FY-20 appropriations to the Commission totaled \$223,228 (HB 2765, Section 38).
