## **Research Analysis**

The Proposed Committee Substitute for HB 3884 extends the sunset on the Commission on County Government Personnel Education to 2025. The measure requires each county commissioner, clerk, treasurer, and court clerk in office on January 1, 2021, and all those elected thereafter, to attend and complete orientation training within 90 days of their first term of office.

Each county commissioner, clerk, treasurer, sheriff, and court clerk would further be required to obtain a Basic Certification by the end of their first term, Advanced I Certification by their second term, Advanced II certification by their third term, and six additional hours of continuing education per calendar year thereafter. Any of these officers who fail to complete the training requirements would forfeit their monthly travel allowance.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure re-creates the Commission on County Government Personnel Education and Training through July 1, 2025, modifies the training requirements for elected county officials and provides for the forfeiture of monthly travel allowances for noncompliance. A determination of any costs or savings resulting from the provisions remains pending, however the Commission is to provide guidance to the Cooperative Extension Service in designing curricula to be used in educational programs and contract with the Cooperative Extension Service at Oklahoma State University to administer training programs. FY-20 appropriations to the Commission totaled \$223,228 (HB 2765, Section 38).
