Research Analysis

HB 3884, as introduced, extends the sunset on the Commission on County Government Personnel Education to 2025. The measure requires each county commissioner, clerk, treasurer, and court clerk in office on January 1, 2021, and all those elected thereafter, to attend and complete orientation training within 90 days of their first term of office.

Each county commissioner, clerk, treasurer, sheriff, and court clerk would further be required to obtain a Basic Certification by the end of their first term, Advanced I Certification by their second term, and Advanced II certification by their third term. Any of these officers who fail to complete the training requirements would forfeit their monthly travel allowance.
