Research Analysis

HB 3893, as introduced, directs the State Department of Education (SDE) to create and maintain an electronic repository of individual student photographs for the purpose of providing a current photograph of a child to law enforcement if the child is identified as missing.

The inclusion of a student's photograph is optional and up to the discretion of the parent. School districts are directed to send an annual notice to parents with information about the repository, and a form allowing the parent or guardian to include their child's photograph.

The measure requires the SDE, with assistance from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, to create and maintain a list of missing Oklahoma school children which shall be updated and distributed to all Oklahoma school districts on a monthly basis.

Lastly, the measure requires law enforcement, whenever they've received a report of a missing child, to inform all on-duty officers of the missing child report, and enter it into the National Crime Information Center system, within two hours of receiving it.
