Fiscal Analysis

The first proposed committee substitute for HB 3894 establishes mandates for institutions of higher education with regards to the processing of absentee ballots.

Consultation with the fiscal analyst for higher education indicated that the mandates of the measure would have a minimal fiscal impact, if any, and could be absorbed by current appropriations. Thus, the measure is not expected to have a direct impact on the state budget.
