Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3906 creates the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act defines *small farm producer* as a person who produces annually no less than 100 vines of sound, ripe grapes, 1,000 pounds of other sound, ripe fruit or berries, or 100 pounds of honey. The measure allows small farm producer licensees to contract with small farm winery licensees, conduct wine tastings, sell wine manufactured from their own produce, and serve and sell Oklahoma-manufactured wine with nonalcoholic beverages or food items.
