**Research Analysis**

HB 3907, as introduced, expands the scope of the Oklahoma Energy Independence Act. Current law allows only commercial property to take part in commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) programs. This measure allows property used for commercial, industrial, educational, agricultural, or nonprofit purposes. Residential property is specifically excluded.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Officials with the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma (ACCO) indicate the measure will have no state fiscal or revenue impact. The measure includes provisions related to the Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) program and includes provision for foreclosure on PACE liens.
