Research Analysis

The Floor Amendment for HB 3942 makes multiple modifications.

The amendment requires the Department of Career and Technology Education to authorize and fund the statewide system of dropout prevention and credit recovery, instead of the State Board of Education.

The amendment removes the provision that each dropout prevention course receive a base level of funding of \$100,000. The amendment also makes the implementation of the program pursuant to the availability of funds.
