**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3942 requires the State Board of Education, pursuant to the availability of funds, to authorize a statewide system of dropout prevention and credit recovery programs by the first semester of the 2020-2021 school year. The measure lists requirements for the programs.

The proposed committee substitute allows the programs to be provided jointly by an Oklahoma Public school and technology center. The technology center and public school shall establish an understanding specifying a dedicated percentage of state funding that will be attributed to the operation of the program.

Additionally, the State Department of Education shall make available a base funding level of \$100,000 per instructor in approved dropout prevention and credit recovery programs.
