Research Analysis

HB 3952 creates the Oklahoma Universal Changing Station Act which requires all public buildings constructed after January 1, 2021 that can hold at least 200 persons to install at least one universal changing station in a family restroom for persons with a physical disability. The station must be at least eight feet by ten feet, be equipped with an adjustable changing table, and comply with all accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Government agencies may coordinate with nonprofits to implement this act.
