**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3956 exempts medical marijuana testing laboratories and transporter agents that were licensed by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from the two-year or five-year Oklahoma residency requirement for obtaining a license. The measure also removes the requirement that medical marijuana transport vehicles have a GPS, reduces the annual fee for a transporter license from \$100 to \$25, and removes the requirement to produce proof of residency in order to obtain a transporter registry I.D. card.
