**Research Analysis**

HB 3970 directs the Corporation Commission to promulgate rules allowing natural gas utilities to procure, transport and deliver renewable natural gas. Customers would be able to choose renewable natural gas as their energy option. The rules would update the state's renewable fuel standard to promote biogas, renewable natural gas and hydrogen as solutions for reducing methane emissions.
