Fiscal Analysis

HB 3992 in its current form increases certain liability limits in The Governmental Tort Claims Act by 50-60%. The increased limits result in increased potential liability to the State. The modifications in the measure increases the liability for each claim by 50-60%. The amount of increased liability to the State is dependent on the number of applicable claims brought against the State.
